A motion was made and carried to move forward with manning the concession stand. John will take the lead.

Discussion on hosting an auction on our Facebook page. John will have more information at our next meeting so we can decide if we want to move forward with it.

3. **Booster Officers** – Discussion on officers for the coming year. An email will be sent out to see if anyone is interested in any officer positions. Currently, Kenneth Stevens is willing to step up to President and Donna Sams is willing to continue as Secretary. We need to find candidates for Vice President, Treasurer and Fundraising Chair.
4. **Treasurer's Report** – Scott reported that we have not received the money from the online fruit sales. Discussion about sending an email to parents to remind them of band camp fees. Our current balance looks healthy.

5. **Band Director's Report** – No March concert is scheduled. Most classes have made a lot of progress and have been working on several styles of music. It does not appear that we will be doing All County this year and RU is not doing Chamber Winds. We will be going to Belle Heth in April for instrument day for 6th grade. The spring concert is scheduled for May 3rd. The next two booster meetings are April 12th and May 10th. Graduation is May 27th. We will do a Memorial Day performance at Bisset Park, followed by our awards picnic on May 30th. We will also have officer and Drum Major interviews coming up. If you have any ideas for the show, feel free to send them to Daniel. The drum line has been playing at the basketball games and will travel to states.

We are still missing some uniforms, so we need to get marching uniforms back from the kids.
